

How do I play Treasure Hunt? How do I find Treasure?

It's very simple really. First, you have to go to the Treasure Hunt map of "Islandia," which you can get to by selecting the link marked "Treasure!" that we've plastered all over our iwin. web site, including:

- the iwin.com home page [insert link],
- the iwin.com games page [insert link], and
- your very own "My iwin" page.

The link to the Treasure Hunt game looks like this:

At the Treasure Hunt game site, you'll find a Treasure Chest with a note nailed on it by the charming Pirate Captain we've entrusted (we're a bit loose with that word) to manage this adventure. After glancing at his love letter to you, click on the lock that looks like this:

Clicking on the lock takes you to the treasure map of Islandia, where all the treasure lies "buried" under the tiny individual picture elements (called pixels) that make up the image of the map.

From this point on, all you have to do is click on the map. The Pirate Captain will inform you if you've found any treasure underneath that particular pixel, and what he thinks of your performance so far.

If you've dug up a prize, follow the link to cash in on your loot. If not, try to endure the abuse of the Pirate Captain, and follow the link back to the map to continue your digging. A red square will mark the site where you last clicked, and you can proceed from there.

By the way, it helps to have a good sense of direction, so you might want to pay attention to the Pirate Captain's instructions. If he's in a good mood, he'll send you towards some treasure; if not, you're going to get a sun burn and a tongue-lashing.

Every ten minutes during the Sponsor's Sweepstakes Period, a new Treasure Hunt game takes place. At the beginning of a new 10-minute game period, 10 prize pixels are randomly scattered all over the map. One of those prize pixels contains a money prize; the others conceal icoi n prizes. The first player to click on a pixel hiding a prize wins the prize associated with that spot on the map. After fifty money prizes --ranging from \$10 to \$10,000-- have been won on any given day, icoi n prizes will be substituted for money prizes in all the remaining ten-minute game periods for the rest of that day.
